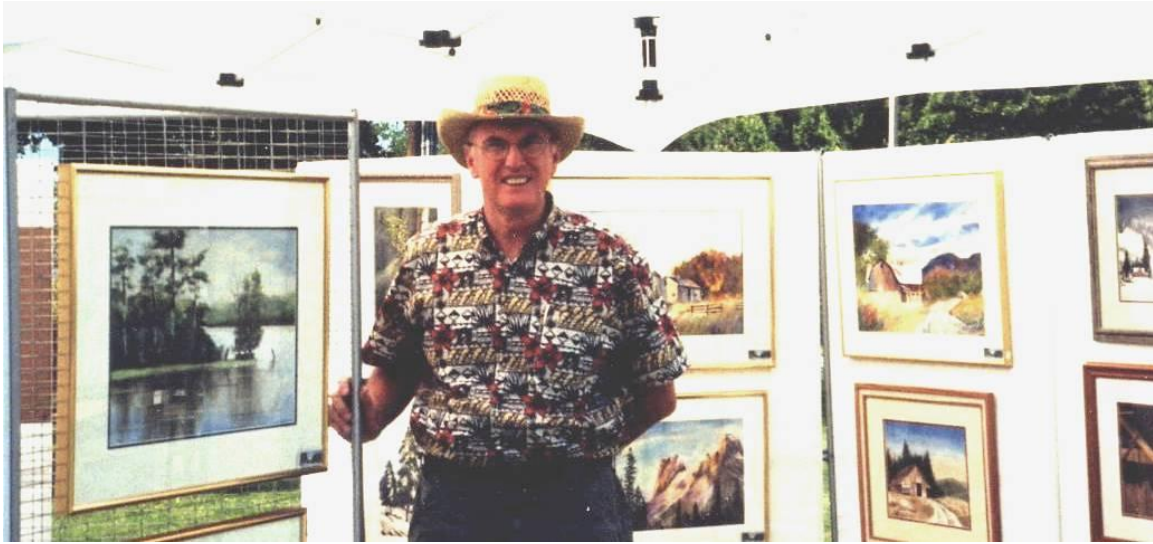


## BIOGRAPHY
